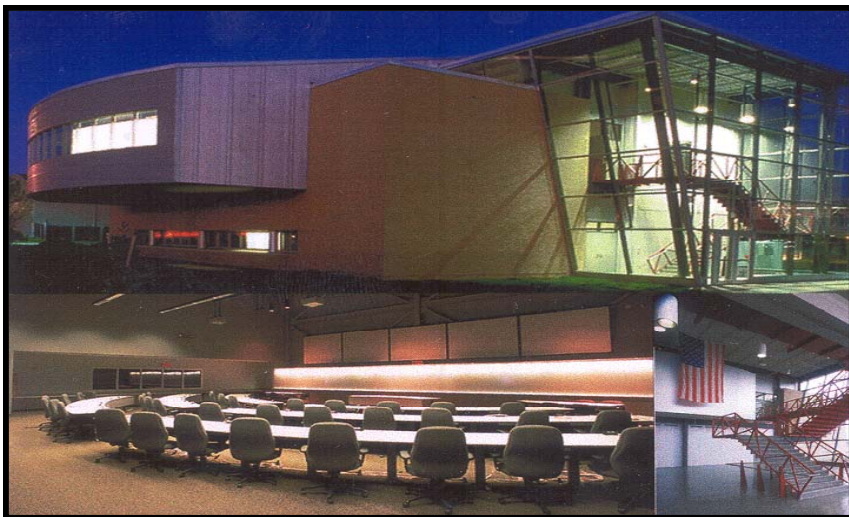


**Public Safety Training Facility

The Air Rescue Fire Training Facility is one of Monroe County's most ambitious high profile projects to date. On a 17-acre site adjacent to the Greater Rochester International Airport, it is the most advanced and extensive training facility of its type in the United States. The nucleus of this complex is an 80,000 square foot multi-functional building for emergency agencies surrounded by an annex for advanced fire training and ten fire fighting props. These props include smoke and burn buildings and a partial jet mockup.
